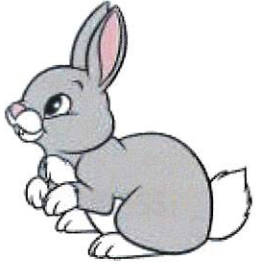




ANIMAL & ME

 Small Animal Barn

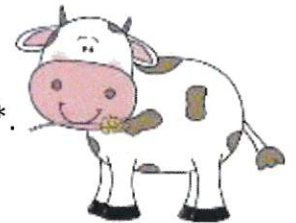


WHAT IS IT?

- Animal & Me is an opportunity for youth and young adults with special needs to participate in a livestock showmanship class.
- Participants select a 1st, 2nd & 3rd choice animal they would like to work with.
- Participants will spend 1 hour with a Jr. Fair Board Mentor with adult supervision learning how to touch, brush, handle & talk about their animal.
- Participants will then enter the show ring and show off what they have learned for a judge!
- All participants will receive an award

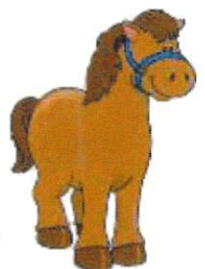
WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- All youth or young adults between the ages of 9 and 22 with special needs*.
- Must live in Carroll County or attend a school in Carroll County.
