

Prior to the Board Meeting, a public hearing was held from 4:30-5:00 p.m. to discuss moving two (2) inside mills to the Permanent Improvement Fund for the purpose of funding the local portion of an OFCC Prek-5 elementary building.

Superintendent Quattrochi took questions from those in attendance and explained that 2 mills would cost the owner of a \$100,000 home, \$62.00 per year.

Lynn Fairclough was also on hand to provide information and answer questions.

When questioned why we are not voting to pass a tax to fund the project, Dr. Quattrochi answered that the OFCC is going to pay 41% of the cost right now. Carrollton was three years away from receiving funding, but the OFCC recently called indicating that they could fund us now, if we could provide our local share. Our State percentage of funding would drastically shrink if we waited three years.
